

Color Matching of 12-Core Optical Cable





Overview

The TIA-598 standard defines a specific 12-color sequence for identifying individual strands. The basic fiber color code uses 12 distinct colors, cycled in groups of 12 for higher-count cables: These 12 colors are defined by TIA/EIA-598-C and followed by cable manufacturers worldwide. OM3 is a laser-optimized multimode fiber (LOMMF) designed for high-speed networks using VCSELs (Vertical-Cavity Surface-Emitting Lasers). The aqua color (hex: #00B6C1) is instantly recognizable and signals support for 10, 40, or 100 Gb/s over short distances — up to 300 meters at 10G.
