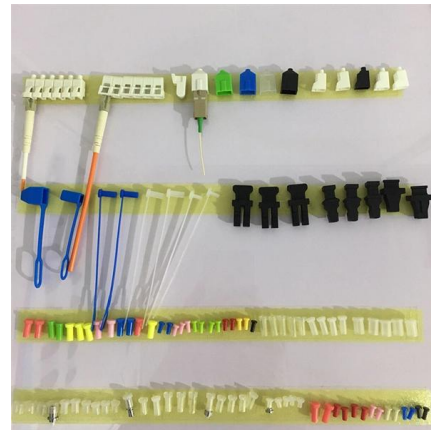
This is not surprising: eyepieces and small reading telescopes were useful adjuncts around a physics department, and were often borrowed. Many physics departments used to have a small cardboard

2x barlow is most common Chosen wisely, a barlow can double your eyepieces 40 mm, 26 mm, 10 mm + 2x barlow = 20 mm, 13 mm, 5 mm Placing barlow ahead of the diagonal gives ~ 50% more

Eyepieces for your telescope basically come in just two sizes, but several other standard sizes do exist. All eyepieces are threaded at the bottom in order to accommodate filters.

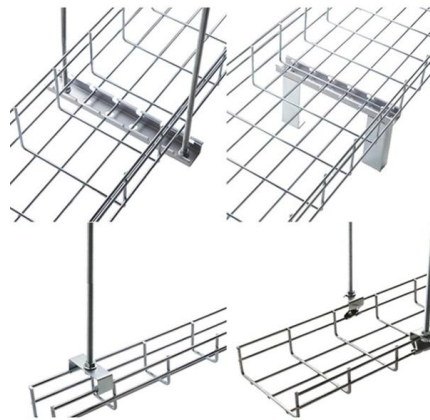

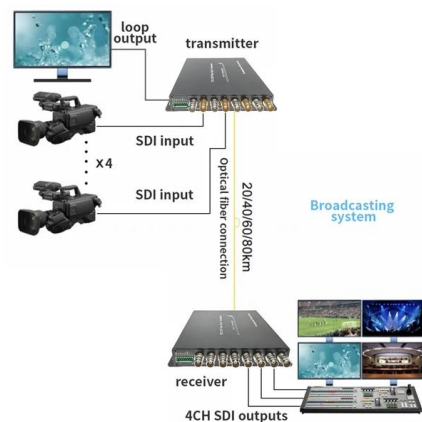
