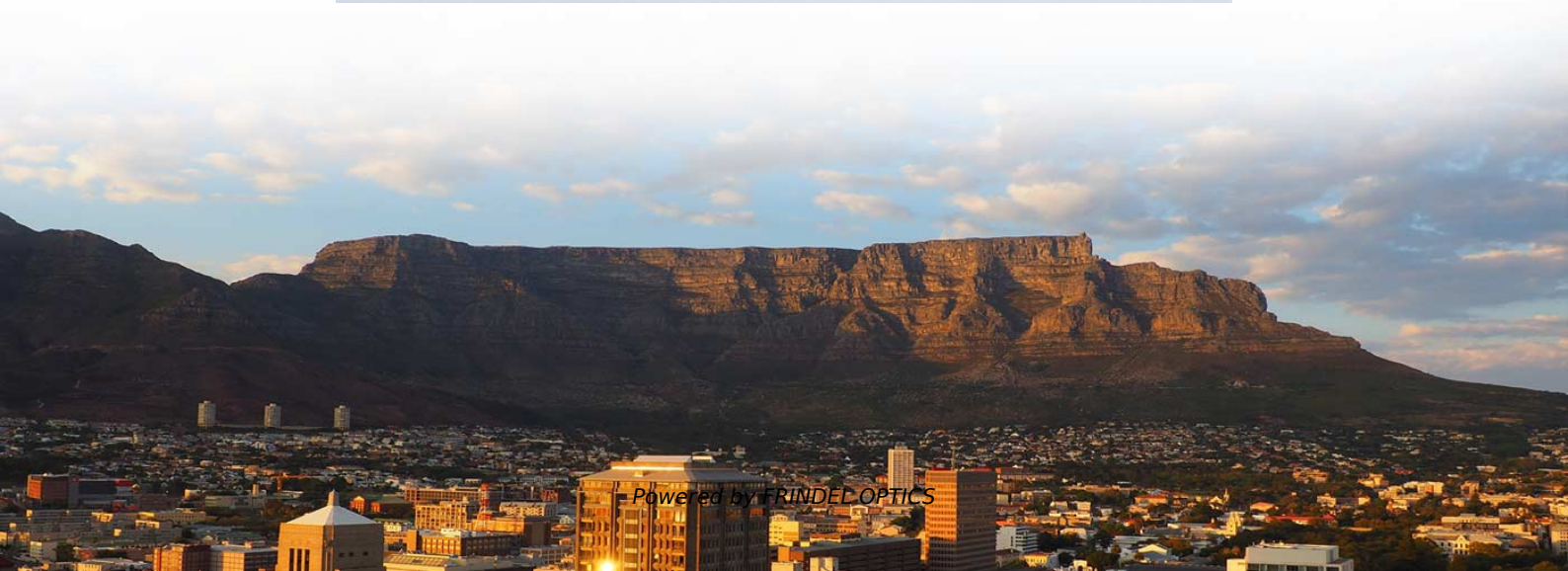

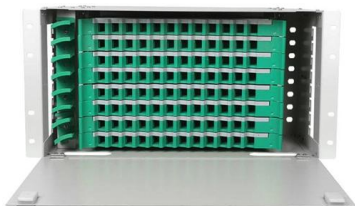

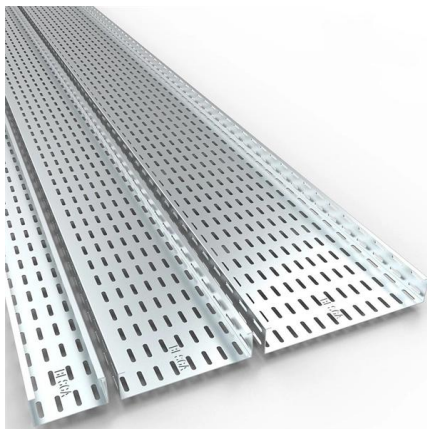
As a SAN design best practice, edge switches should connect to at least two core switches with trunks of at least two ISLs each. Each of those trunks should be attached to a different blade/port group.

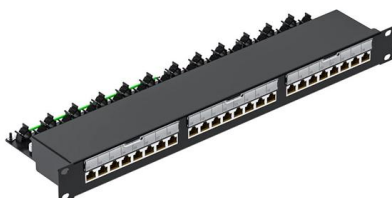
