Aisle Length: ➔ When racks or equipment cabinets are aligned to form a continuous aisle, the aisle should not exceed 16 meters in length. Efficient airflow management in data centers relies heavily on proper Hot Aisle and Cold Aisle configurations. System to include demountable ceiling supported wall panels above the equipment racks and floor supported door assembly at each end of the contained requirements: Glazing to meet or exceed ASTM seal the gap between the panels and the cabinets. When implemented correctly, they improve efficiency, reduce energy consumption, extend equipment life, and enhance overall reliability. Hot aisle containment consists of a physical barrier that guides hot exhaust airflow back to the AC return.
