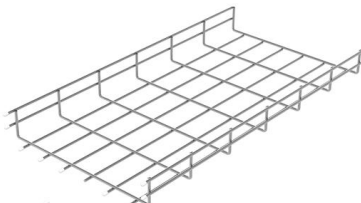

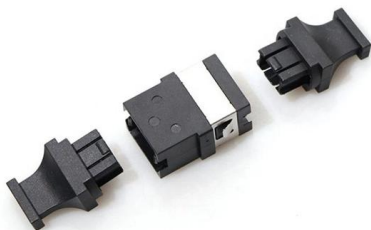

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What You Should Know about Marker Posts and How to Use Them

Marker posts are ideal for identifying buried electric cable, fiber optic routes and gas and water pipelines. While there are several product manufacturers, not all of these products are the same. There are

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Safety Distances from Installation of Medium and Low

For the installation of the fiber optic cable, a minimum vertical distance of 1.80m in medium voltage line and 0.60m in low voltage line must be considered.

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Recommendations for Marking Communication Facilities

Recommended 400ft. (100m) maximum distance between markers with a preferred distance of 200ft. (50m) between markers. In bends or lateral pipe deflections, it is recommended to place one marker

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FOA Standard For Installing Fiber Optic Cable Plants

Outside plant cables often span distances longer than the limits of manufactured cables (5-15 km typically), Deploying cables of lengths >5km can be difficult, so cables may need to be spliced to
