The distance between the distribution box and the switch box should not exceed 30 meters, and the horizontal distance between the switch box and the fixed electrical equipment it controls should not exceed 3 meters. The conductors and equipment required or permitted by this subpart shall be acceptable only if approved, as defined in § 1910. 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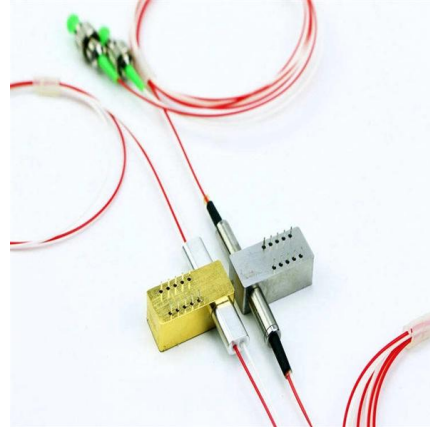

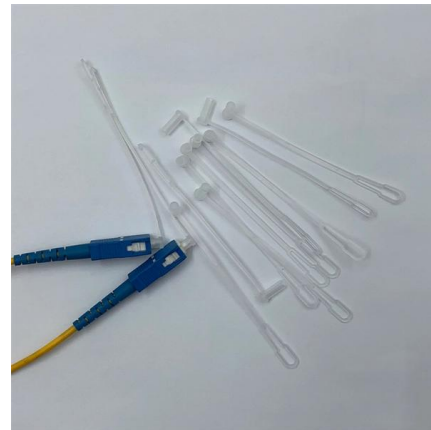
