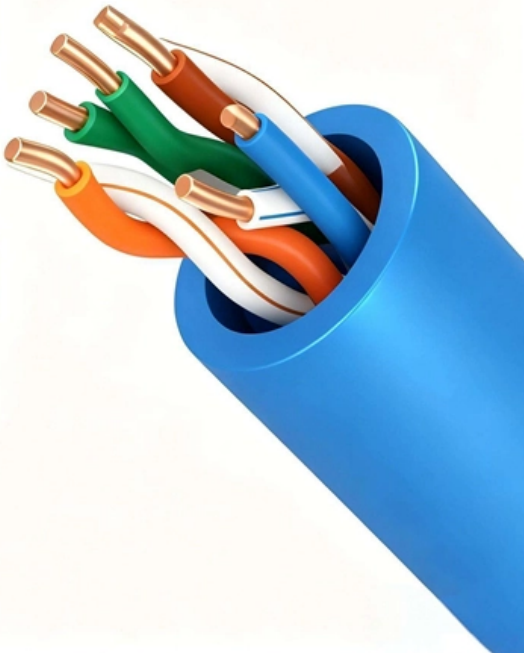

Overview

Optical fibre patch cords, whether they are used for cross connection or interconnection to equipment, shall be of a crossover orientation such that position A goes to position B on one optical fibre, and position B goes to position A on the other optical fibre of. In order to achieve consistent and compatible fibre systems, it is recommended that the convention defined in ISO / IEC 11801 is used where channel A (right) is the input and channel B (left) is the output. Fiber polarity is the direction that light signals travel from one end of a fiber optic cable (link) to the other.
