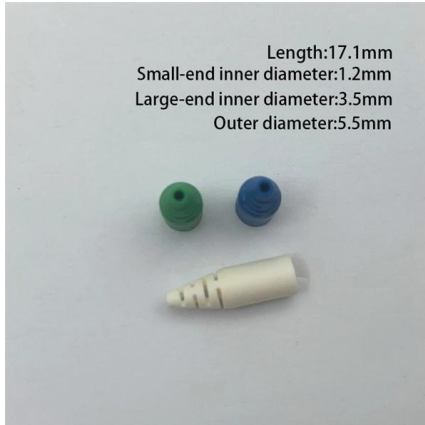


Overview
