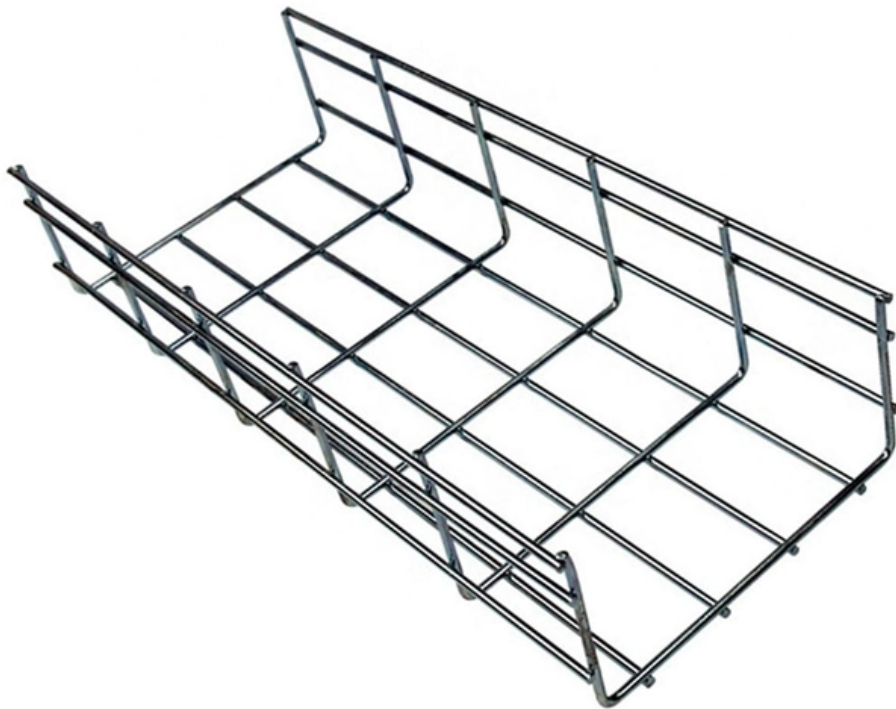

Heat-shrink fiber optic splice closure uses a material that shrinks when heated to form a tight seal around the fiber optic cable, protecting the splice point from moisture, dust, and mechanical damage. There are 7 procedures to perform in the splicing process; roughly in the following order: Procedures 2 and 3 will be performed twice; once for each of the two cables. However, one side will need to have more outer jacket stripped off to make room for the shrink sleeve; to move it out of the. 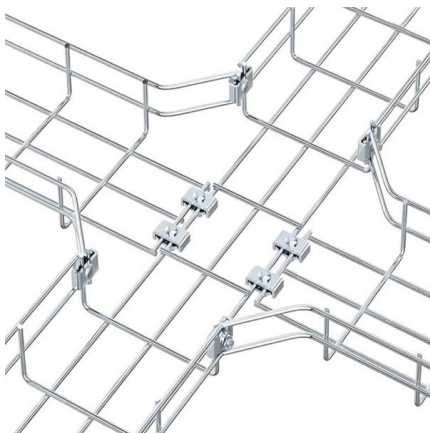

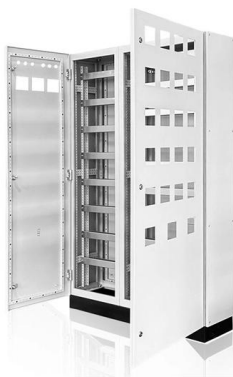

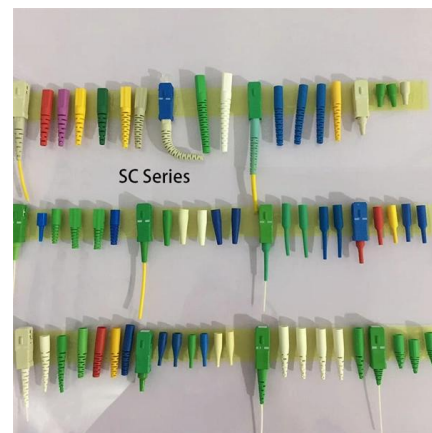
