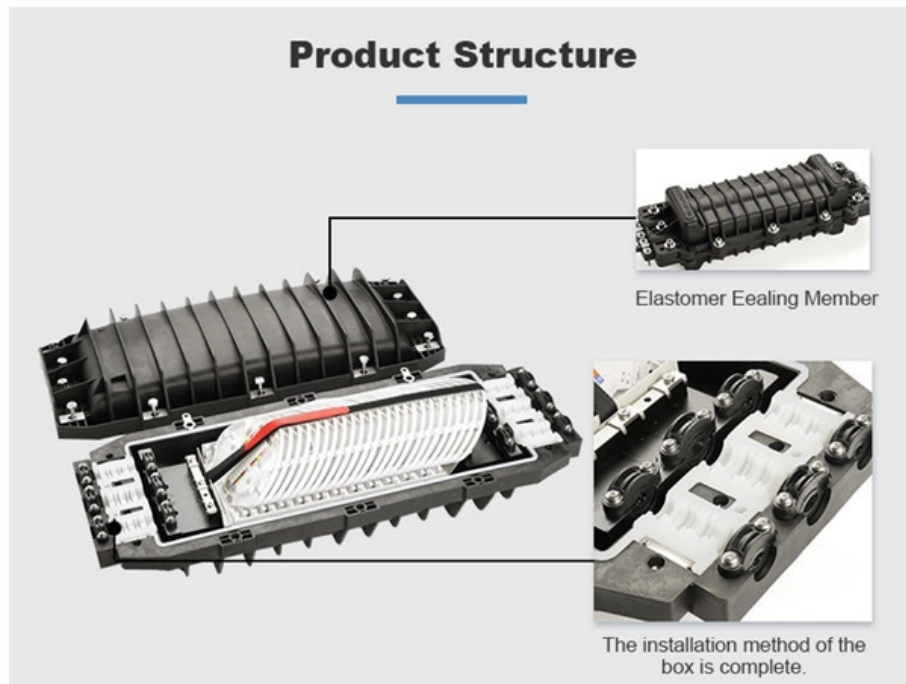


Fiber optic cable cross-section material





Overview

Optical fibers are circular dielectric wave-guides that can transport optical energy and information. Fiber optic cables are designed to provide high-speed, no-signal-loss, and EMI-free communication in telecommunication, powergrid, datacenter, broadband, and industrial applications. A micrometer, or micron (μm), is a metric measurement used to measure the diameter of a fiber.

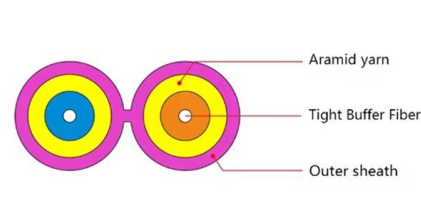

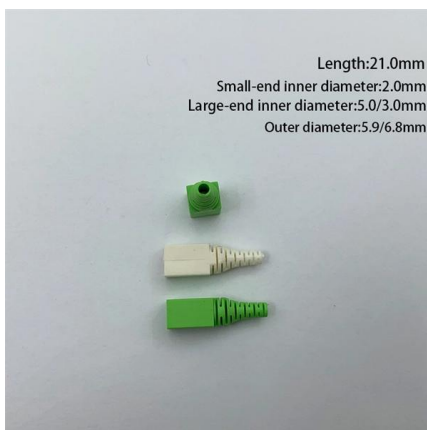

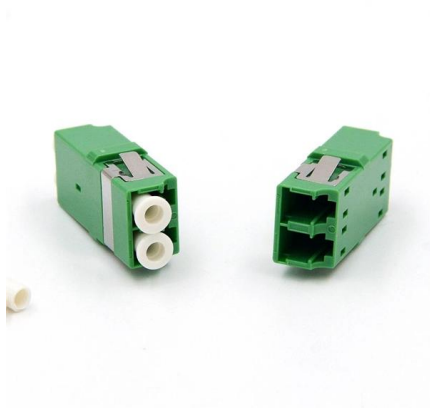
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Cross section of various types of fiber optic cable

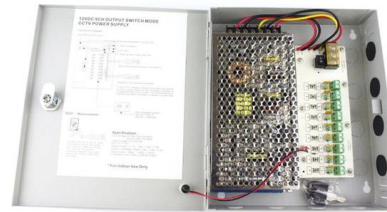
