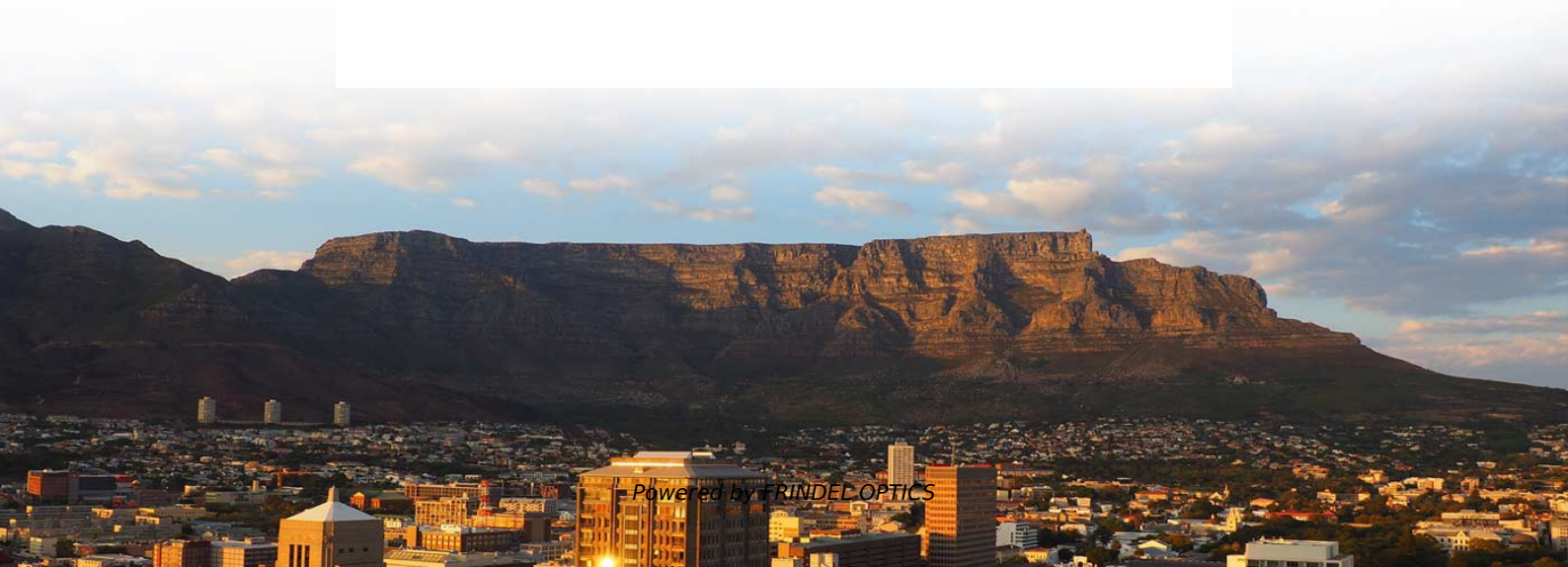
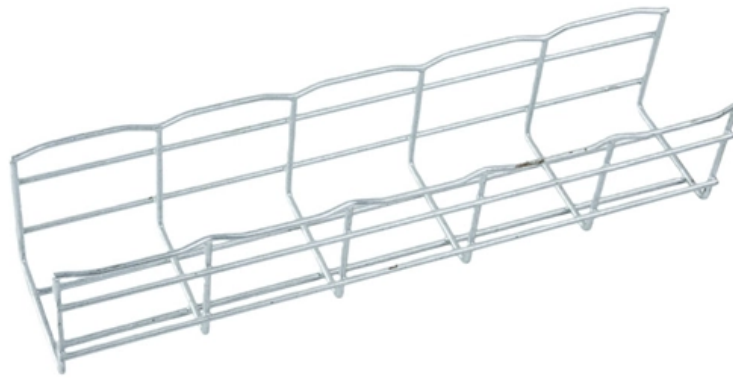


Fiber optic cable withstands pressure when passing through a wall





Overview

Any run through open wall cavities or high-traffic areas should be protected using flexible low-voltage conduit. This protective measure shields the fiber from accidental damage, pests, and future renovations, ensuring the cable's physical integrity remains intact. Pulling tension, the conduit radius and fill ratio all affect this sidewall pressure. Corning recommends maintaining sidewall pressures below the crush load acceptance criteria defined by the manufacturer. Use electrical tape to attach fiber to a string or fish tape by starting well above the cable. Minimize mechanical pressure on the outer sheath at crossing points: (armoured) cables crossing each other generate points of high pressure, so it is important when laying in figure 8 loops it is done in a correct way. 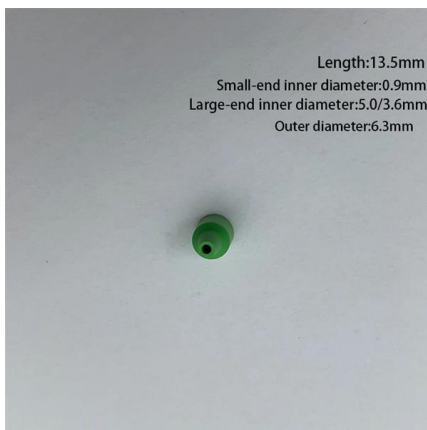

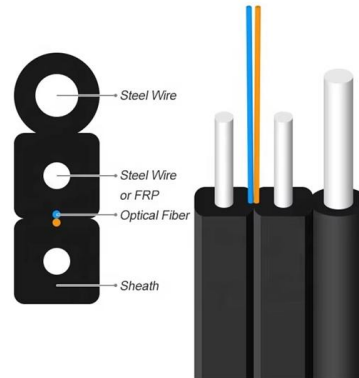
