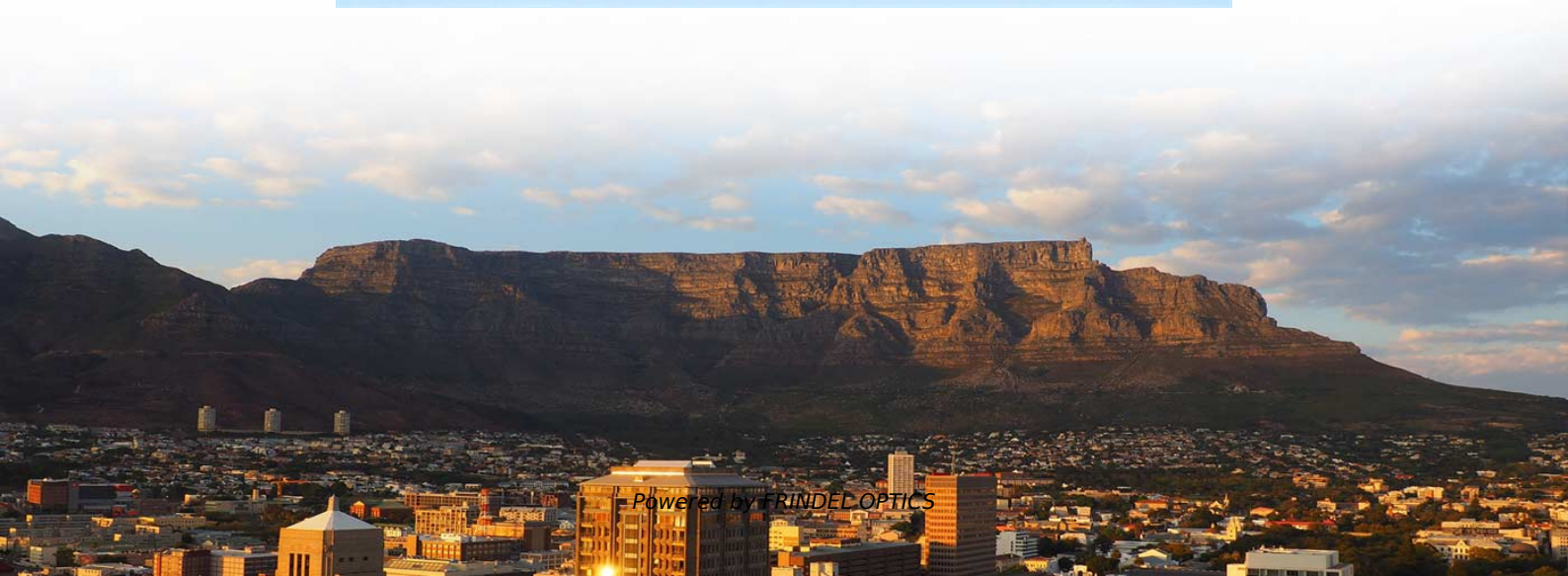

Hoistway Opening Protection

Hoistway opening protection is not required on levels where the hoistway opens to the exterior. Additionally, IBC 3006.2.1 requires hoistway opening protection

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Fireproof installations above fire protection ceilings

For this reason, special cable support and routing systems are used for electrical installations above suspended fire protection ceilings in the area of escape and rescue routes.
