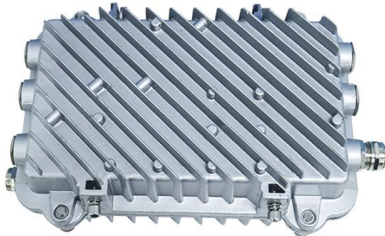


General Diagram for Aerial Optical Cables
