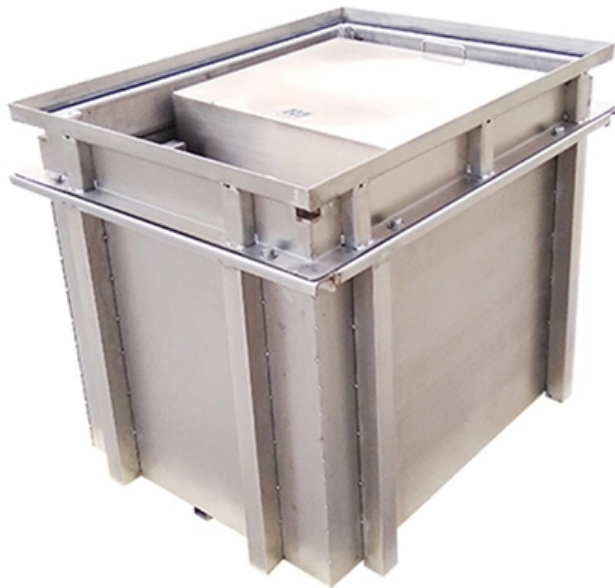
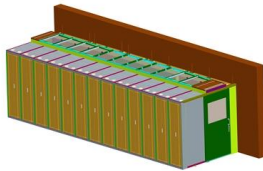

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The height above ground of any wire or cable which is attached to a support carrying any overhead line shall not be less than 5.8 metres at any point where it is over a road accessible to vehicular traffic.

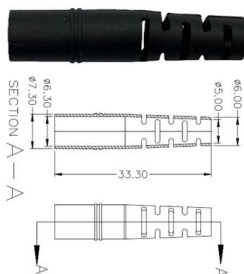

Restrict road crossings to a bare minimum, and if possible, stick to the same side of the road throughout. Avoid trees and where not possible, select a position which will minimise interference from trees -

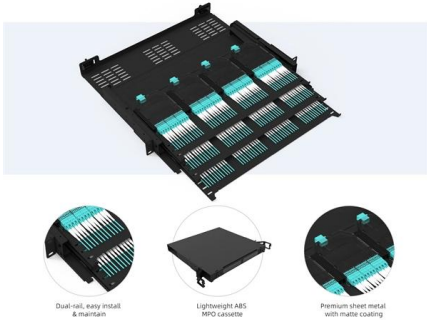

Fiber optic cable sequential numbers are required at each pole location and vault wall. Sequential numbers will identify conduit length, and slack left in vaults and at poles.

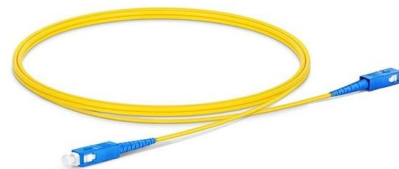

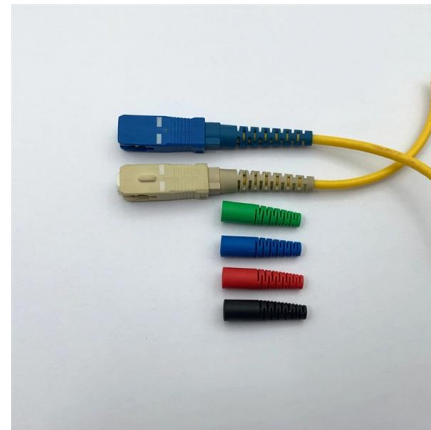
