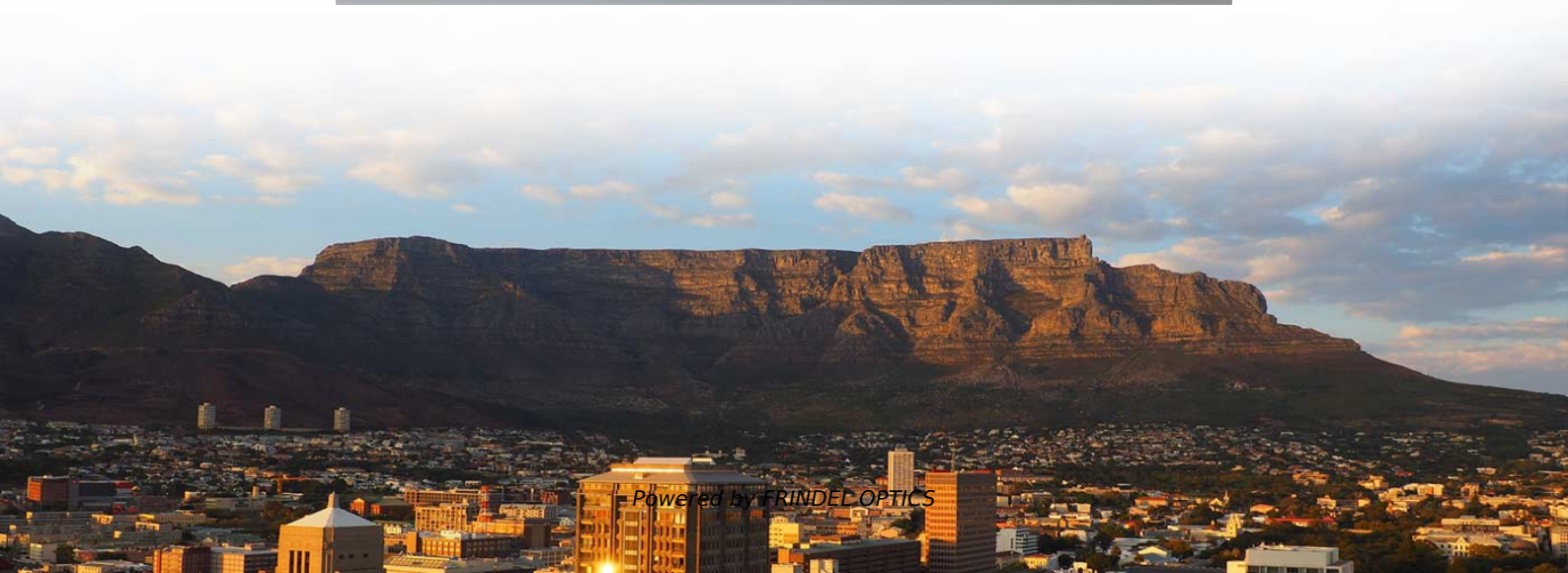
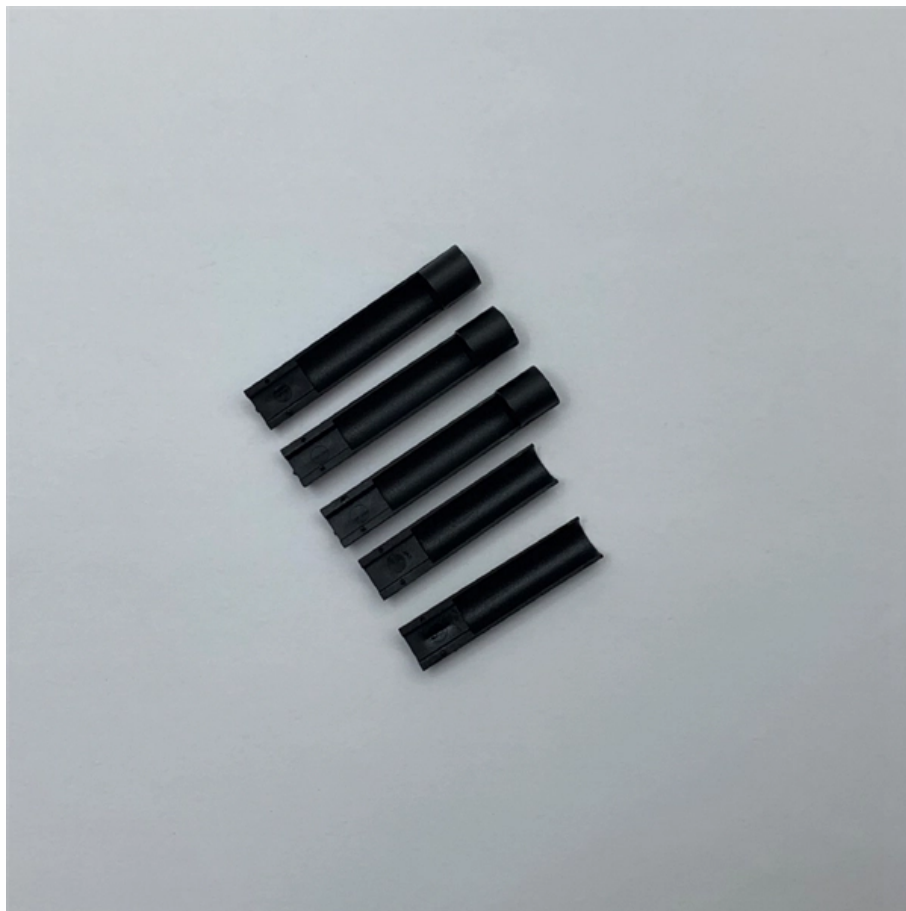

Beam Splitter

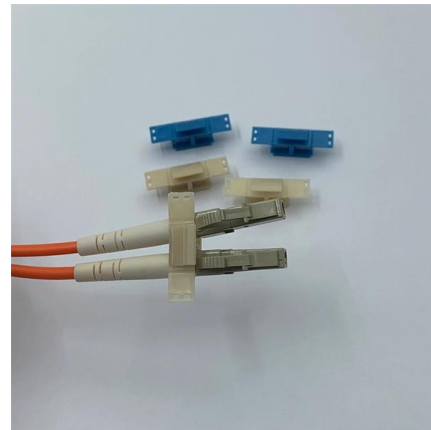
A beam splitter is defined as an optical device that effects a linear transformation of fields presented at two input ports, producing output beams that are related to the input fields in a characteristic manner

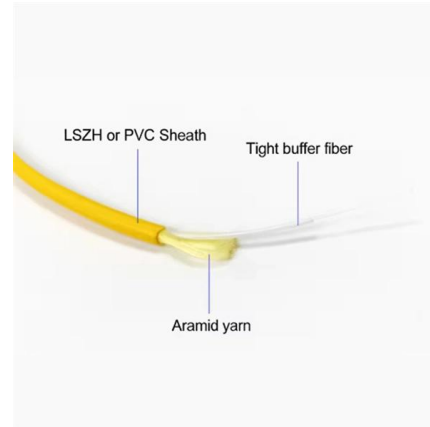

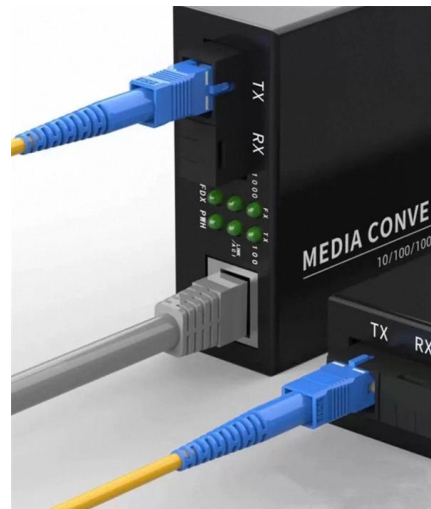

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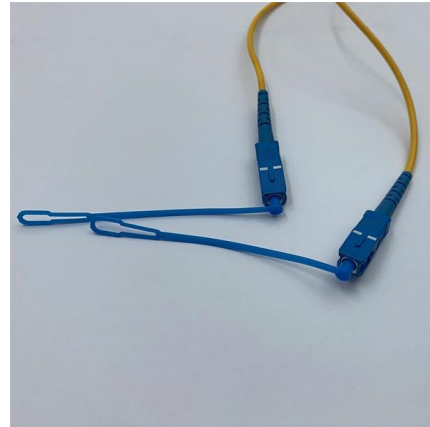
