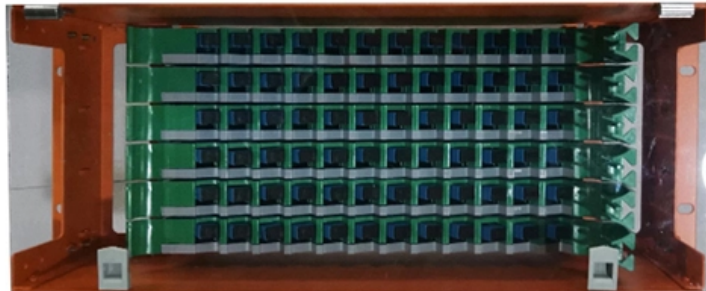


# How to drill through the cable tray cover plate

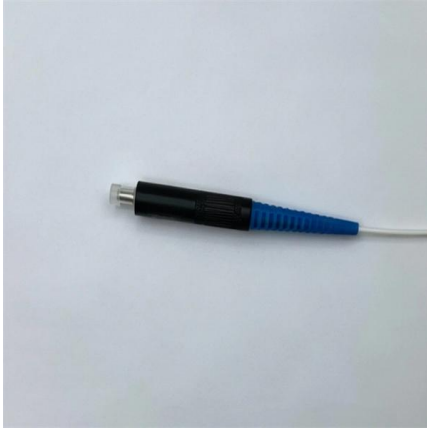

As you can see when we want to take cable for the termination we mostly have to drill holes in the plate. many time from bottom sometimes from top

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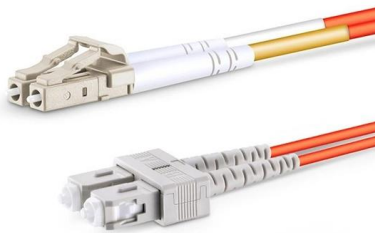
