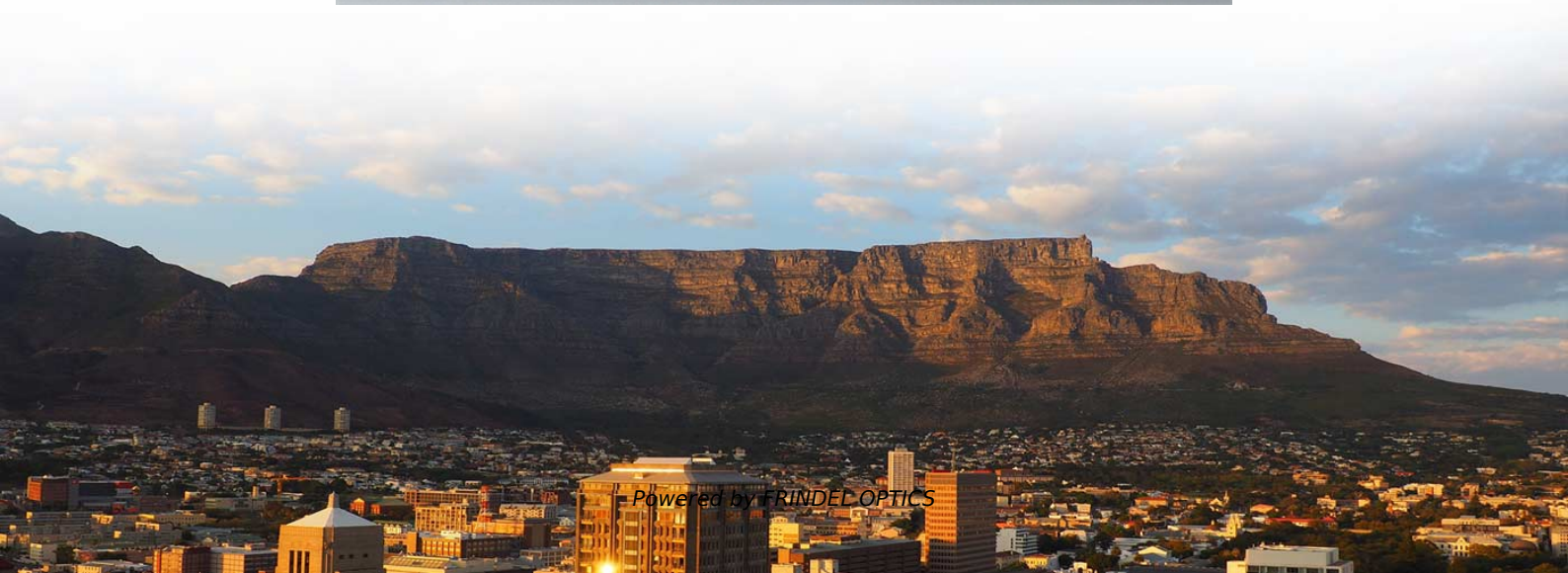


How to insert branch lines into cable trays





Overview

Place screw head on inside of branch cable tray, put the jumper outside of branch cable tray, add flat washer and locknut, then tighten. Cable tray shall be grounded as defined in SAES-P-111 Section 7, 8, and 9 and NEMA VE-2 Section 4. 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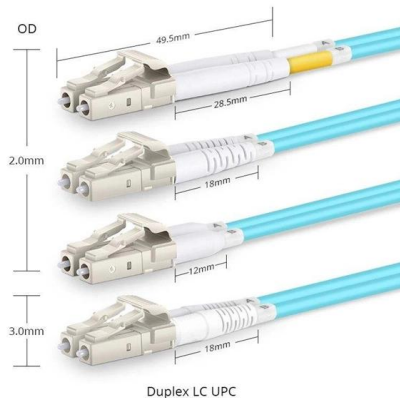

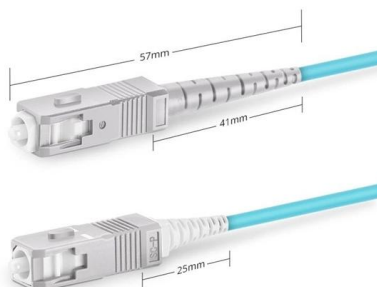
