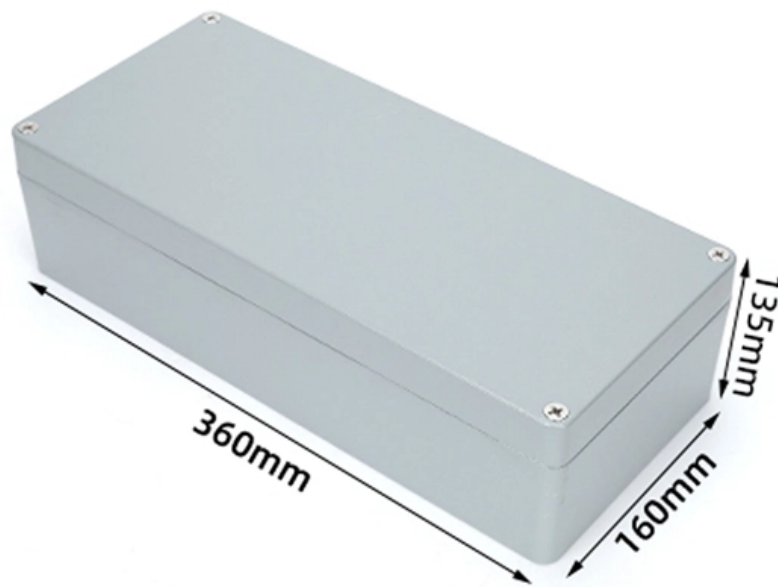


Is it okay to run low-voltage conduit through a cable tray



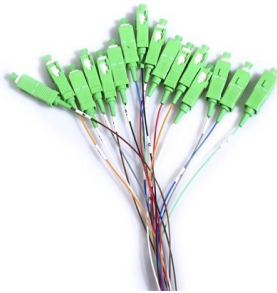


Overview

Multiconductor cables rated over 600 volts shall be separated from lower voltage cables by a separate cable tray or a solid fixed barrier. I believe that open cable tray will be useful and convenient for carrying bundles along the length of the space (about 30x30'), but that conduit will be most appropriate for carrying cable between (the two) floors. Cable tray is the preferred wiring method for industrial facilities, data centers, and large commercial buildings where routing dozens or hundreds of cables through individual conduits would be impractical and expensive. 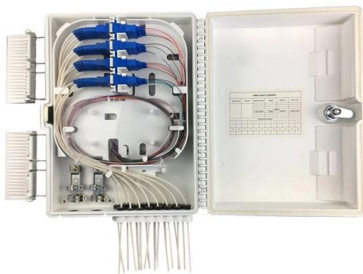
