A pigtail is a coiled or looped section of tubing used in piping and instrumentation systems to absorb vibration, manage thermal expansion, and protect pressure instruments from direct exposure to process media. Moreover, its curved design allows it to flex under temperature or pressure changes. One side features a molded plug or socket, while the opposite has exposed conductors. The pigtails provide flexible connection inside passive equipment, patch panels, ODFs and closures.

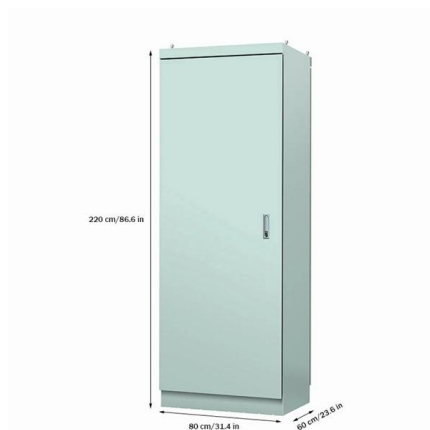

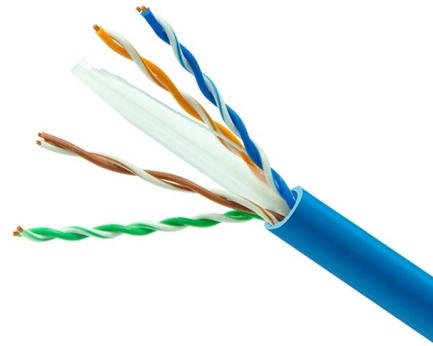

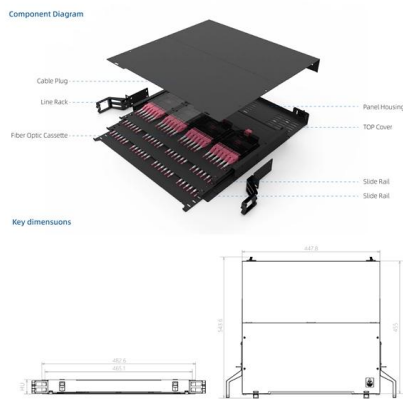
