Electric power distribution is the final stage in the delivery of electricity. Electricity is carried from the transmission system to individual consumers. Distribution substations connect to the transmission system and lower the transmission voltage to medium voltage ranging

The secondary distribution voltage is typically less than 2,000 volts. It is from these distribution transformers that electricity is delivered to customers'

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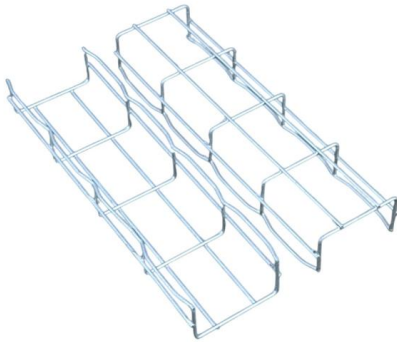


Power Distribution Box Essentials: Functions, Types
