

Raw Materials for Making a Spectrometer





Overview

This instructable teaches you how to build a low-cost spectrometer using simple materials, such as a 100 W light bulb, a light-dependent resistor, a prism or grating, and a curtain. Spectrometry is an analysis technique that enables the identification of material chemical composition, regardless if they are solid or liquid, using the absorption and emission of an incoherent light that hits the surface. Cut two small squares of sturdy cardboard, a bit larger than the end of your tube. Trace the end of your tube onto one of these, then draw another smaller circle a few mm. 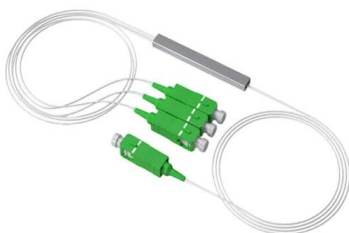

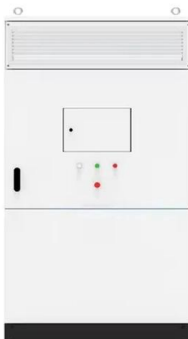

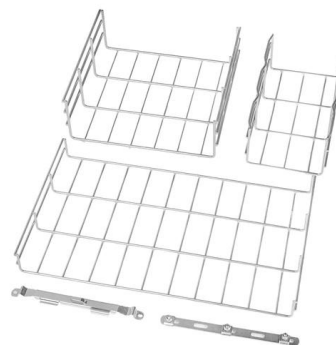
