IEC-60364 and BS-7671 Guidelines for Garage Units, Consumer Units, and Distribution Boards The International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) and the British Standard BS 7671 play pivotal roles in shaping the requirements for electrical installations. The minimum dimensions in Section 729 of BS 7671 apply where certain specific protective measures restricted to skilled and instructed persons are used (not always relevant in the UK). System Optimization Service from Lutron identifies important lighting control adjustments to save additional energy and create a more productive work environment on an ongoing basis.

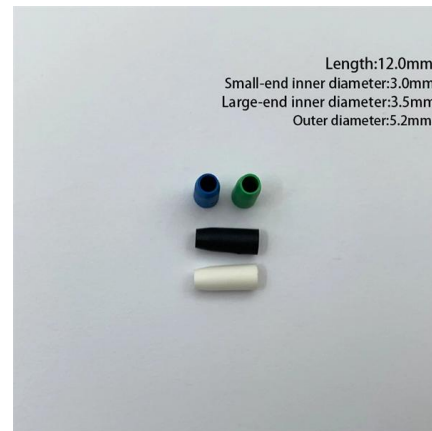

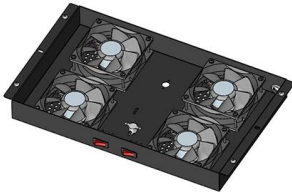
