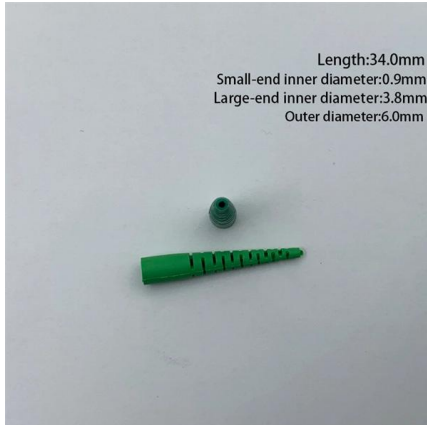

The distance between the ground and the loaded conductor (overhead power line) is known as conductor-to-ground clearance or simply ground clearance. The
