

Safe distance between communication optical cables and power lines





Overview

Industry guidelines recommend: to maintain at least 20 cm (8 inches) between data and power cables when running in parallel; if cables must cross, do so at a 90-degree angle; use separate trays or conduits for high-voltage and communication cables; and for medium-to-high voltage. When a communications cable runs parallel and in close proximity to a power cable, these magnetic fields induce unwanted currents—a phenomenon known as inductive coupling—into the sensitive data conductors. This induced noise can corrupt the low-voltage data signal, leading to network slowdowns. Safety and signal integrity can be maintained by following the separation guidelines for the most common telecommunication pathway designs. 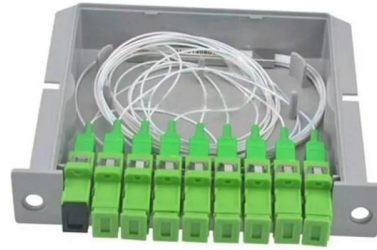

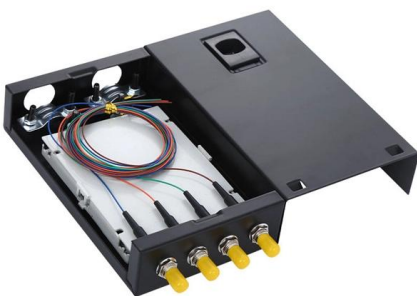

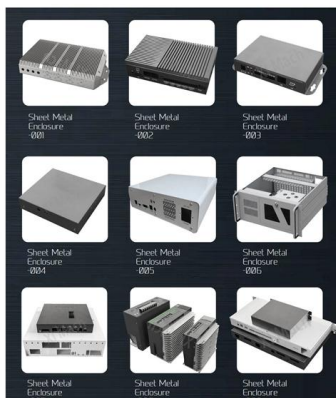
