This setup enhances accessibility for maintenance while preventing direct contact with soil, reducing the risk of damage over time. While they serve the common purpose of routing and securing cables, these systems differ in design, application, installation, and. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend ra-dius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. The problem will be water penetration on both systems and mainly on the last one.

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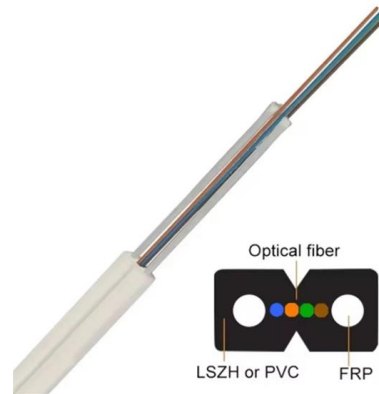

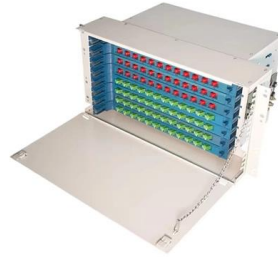
