

Side ventilation of network rack



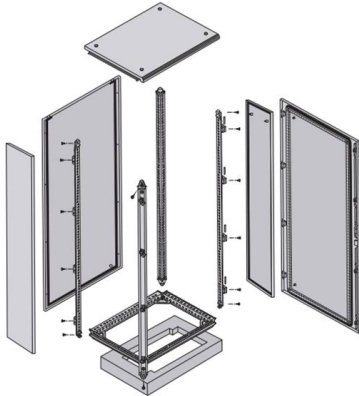


Overview

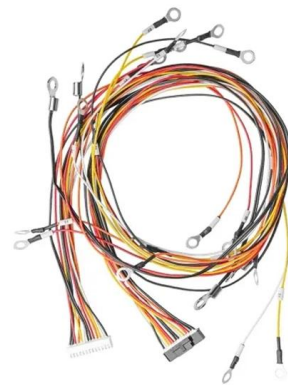
