In situations where space is limited, low-voltage switchgear may be built as "front accessible" where the access load cabling and connections are from the front of the equipment. This allows the low-voltage

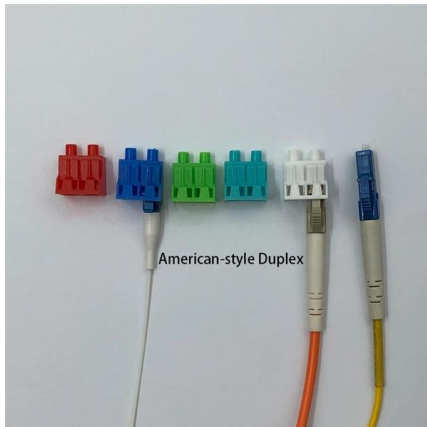

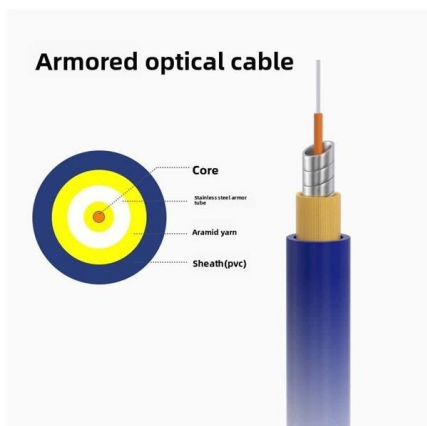
