

Spacing for optical fiber cable coiling





Overview

Fiber optic cable should not be coiled in a continuous direction except for lengths of 100 ft (30 m) or less. Recommendations for Fiber Optic Cable Installation Where reels are supplied with protective material fitted over the cable, the protection should remain in place until the cable will be installed. Some key considerations for installing optical fiber cable are highlighted below. Outdoor cable may be direct buried, pulled or blown into conduit or innerduct, or installed aerially between poles. The rule is to coil the fiber once after each splicing and heat shrinking of one or several optical fibers in fiber optic sleeve or optical fibers in a branch
