

Spacing of horizontal cable tray support brackets





Overview

For horizontal sections where cable trays are laid out in a straight line, the typical support span (distance between supports) should range from 1. Although BS 7671 touches on the subject of cable supports, it does not detail specifically what these support distances should be. 8 (Other Mechanical Stresses (AJ)) in that document provides requirements for cable support. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Proper installation can significantly reduce electromagnetic interference, prevent fire hazards, and improve overall efficiency. 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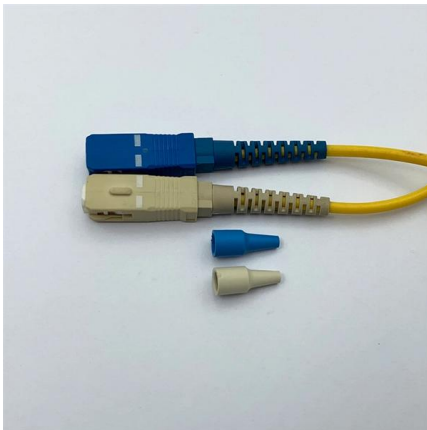

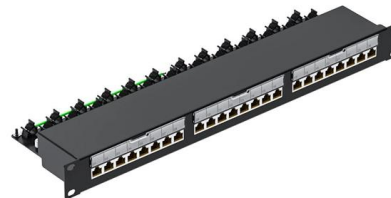
