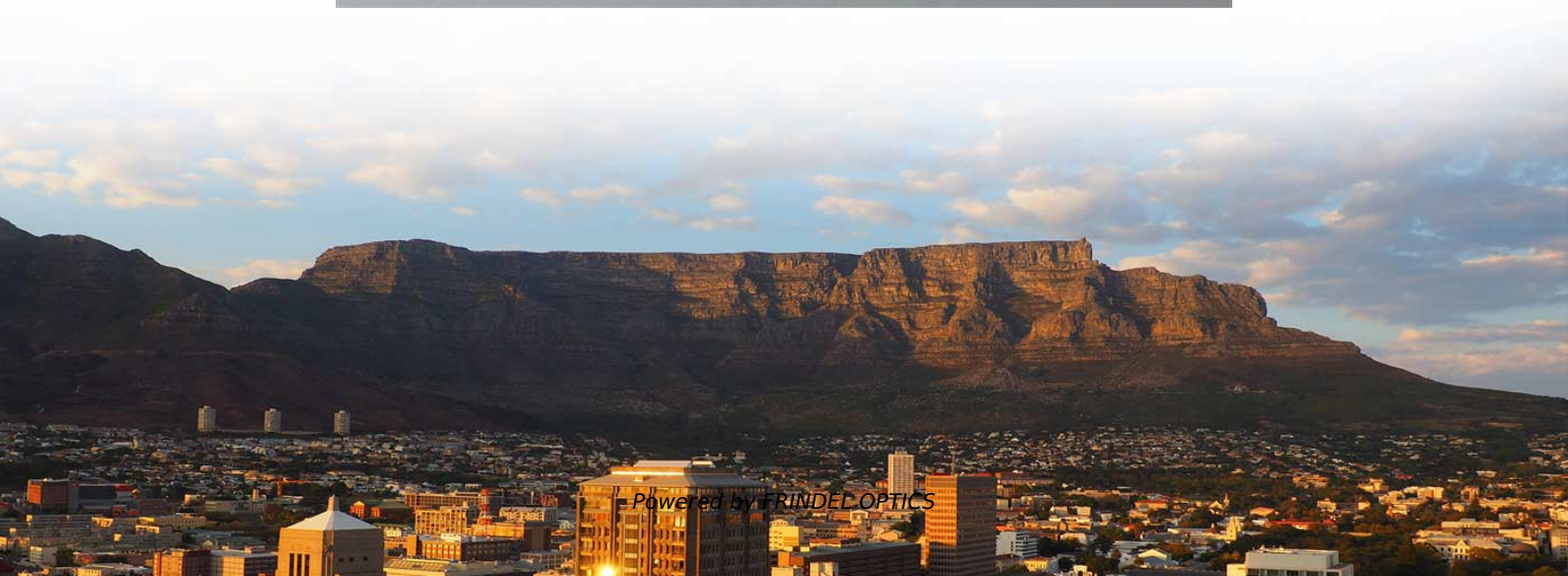
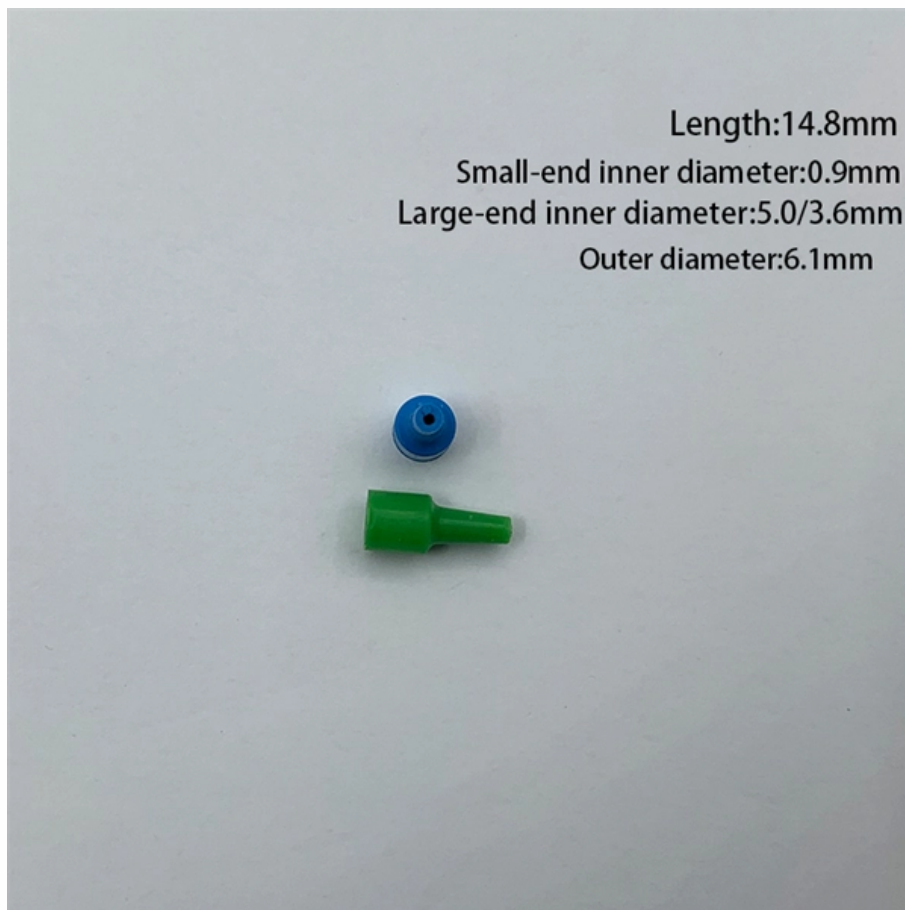


Surface-mounted ground wire in distribution box



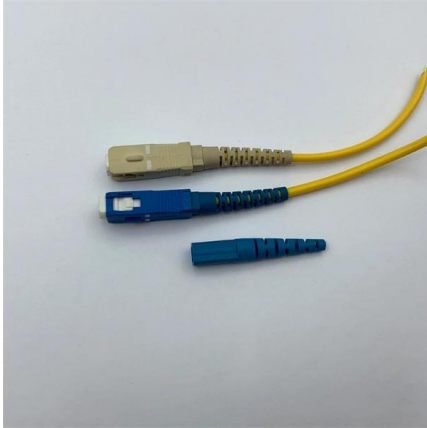


Overview

26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. This Standard Technique defines the earthing design requirements for ground mounted distribution substations which are to be owned or adopted by National Grid Electricity Distribution. Additional rules for the grounding and bonding of industrial control panels include the sizing of ground conductors and the conditions that dictate when power supplies and transformers must be grounded.

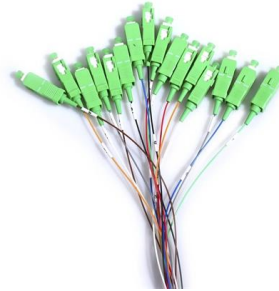

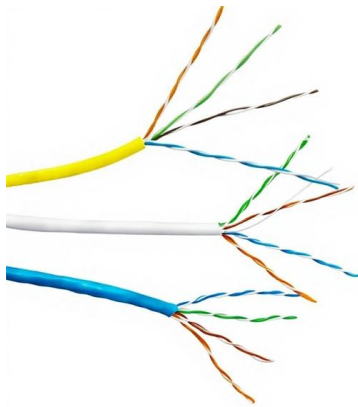
