Overview

An aggregation switch is a network device that consolidates traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, or other edge devices and forwards it to core switches or routers. By bundling multiple network connections into a single high-bandwidth link, aggregation switches help. Amounts or summary statistics are used in place of atomic data rows, which are often collected from several sources when data is aggregated.
