

Temperature Requirements for Power and Communication Equipment Rooms





Overview

Most IT equipment manufacturers specify an optimal operating temperature range, usually between 20 and 25 degrees celsius (68 and 77 degrees Fahrenheit). Operating within this range ensures that the equipment performs at its best and reduces the risk of overheating-related issues. Upon completion of the installation, a third party field verification firm will independently verify. Actual air handling requirements may exceed these guidelines and should be calculated based on potential heating and cooling demand associated with equipment which may be present in the telecommunications entrance room, including, but not limited to: uninterruptible power supplies.

What are the ASHRAE guidelines for data center electrical room
