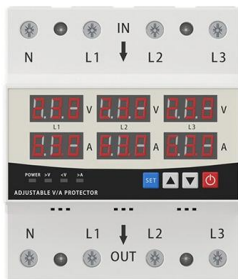

Three-Tier Network Architecture , Data Centers

In a traditional three-tier architecture as defined in ANSI/TIA-942-A-1, servers are connected to core, aggregation and access switches. MPO 12- or 24-fiber cabling is often implemented between core

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In a three tier network architecture, where should the servers be

In this model, you would have at least an access layer switch that connects to the servers and back up to your core stack. If you have several racks, you might do access in top of rack to an end of row

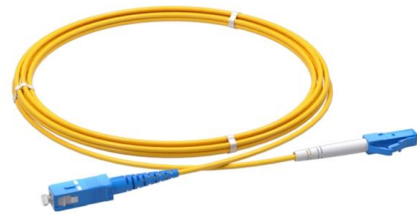

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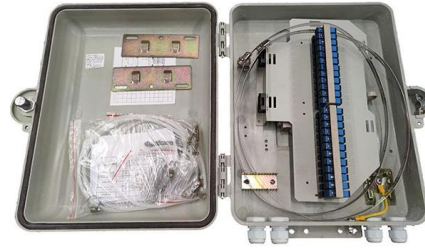
