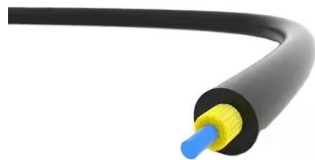

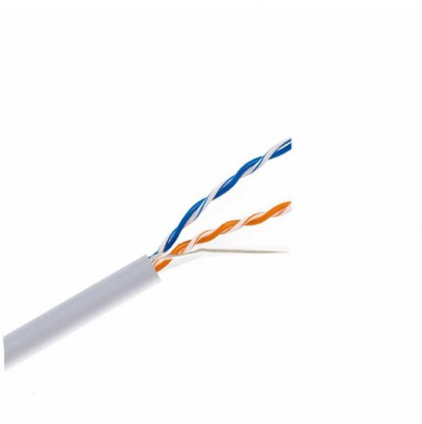

Protective conductors are not current-carrying and are also referred to as PE, which is the abbreviation for "protective earth". This is a safety device to protect against electric shock.

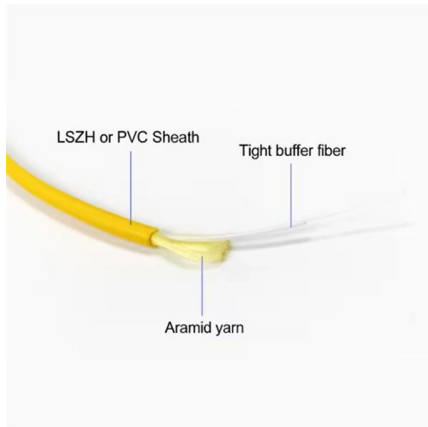
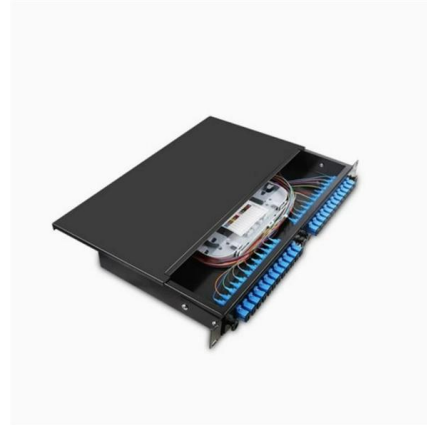
