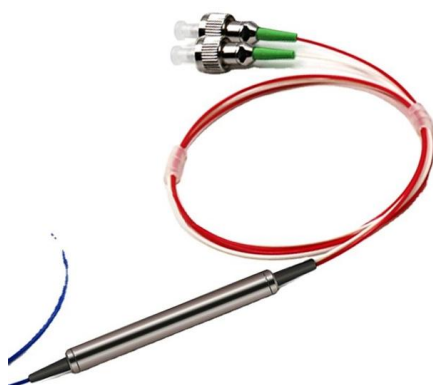
Sufficient pre-installation preparation is the basis for the safe and smooth installation of the distribution box, mainly including the following aspects:
