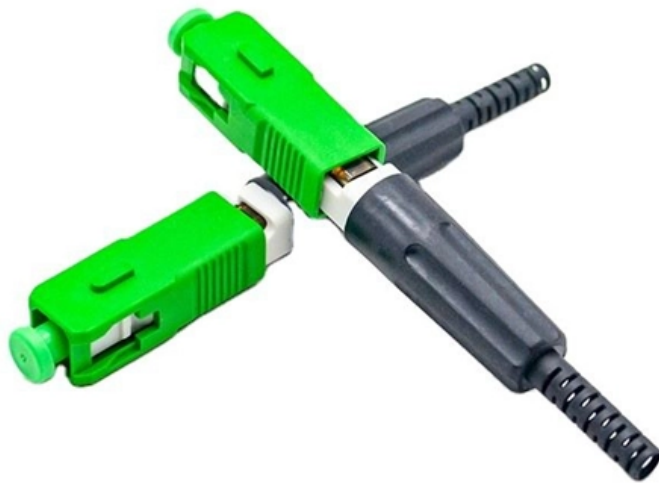

The components, like a circuit breaker have a limited performance (10,000 mechanical operations, 10,000 load current and 50 maximum short circuit operations). With secondary selective service, each distribution transformer must be able to supply the entire load for maximum reliability benefits. 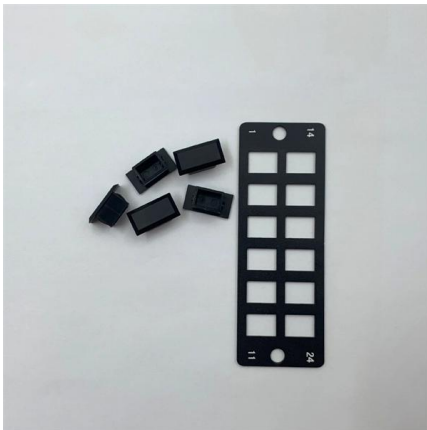

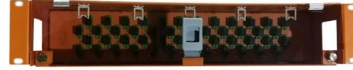
