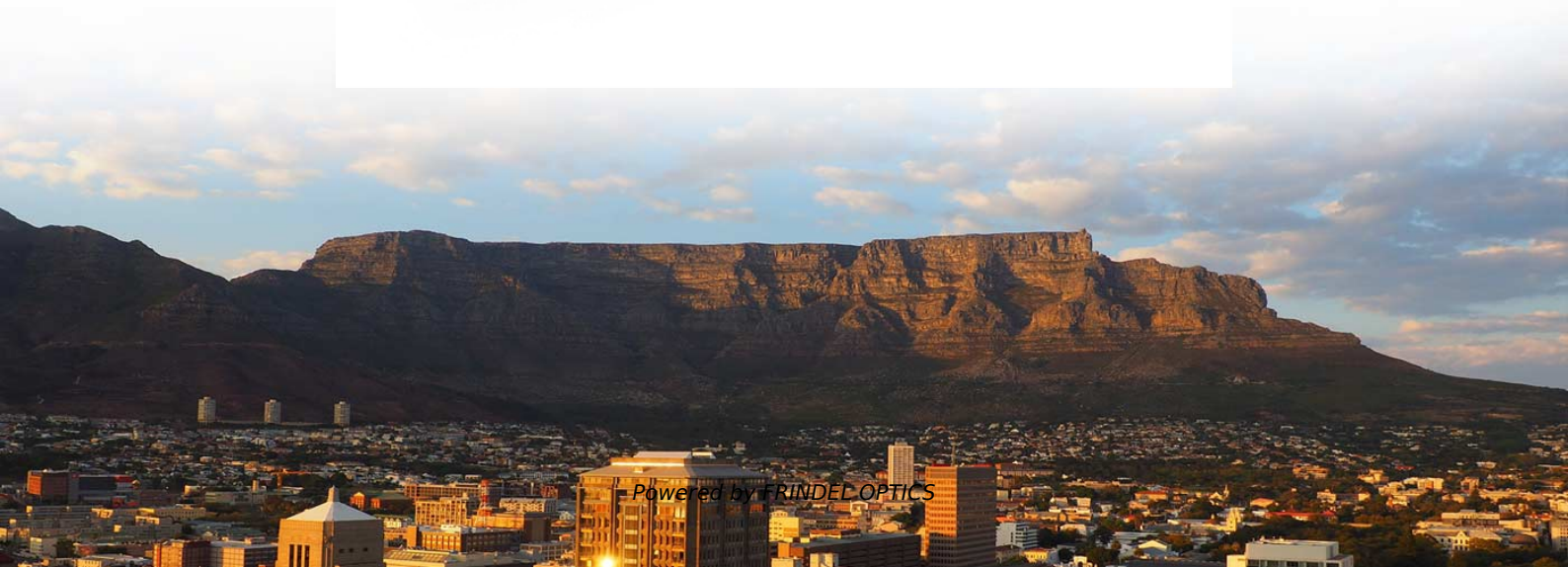


What are the requirements for accepting explosion-proof distribution boxes





Overview

A specification for explosion proof distribution cabinets must include detailed electrical components for hazardous areas, enclosure materials, and cable entry systems. (b) Short-circuit protection shall be provided for each branch circuit connected to a distribution box. Explosion proof equipment is designed to contain internal explosions and prevent ignition of surrounding flammable gases or dust. Unlike standard distribution boxes that could become shrapnel shards in volatile environments, explosion-proof containers are engineered fortresses that absorb, contain, and vent catastrophic blasts without becoming fragmentation bombs themselves.

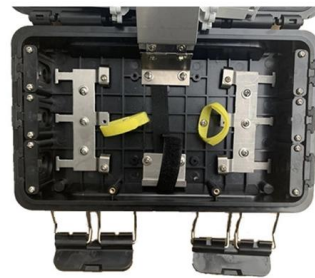

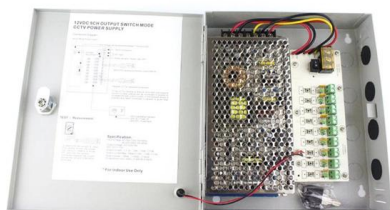

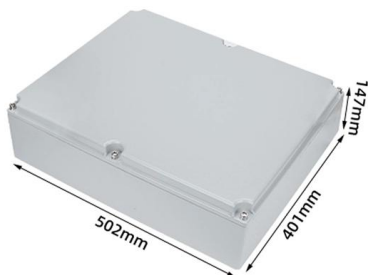
