

What are the voltage values of the neutral and live wires in the distribution box





Overview

To test which wire is neutral and earth out of the two(Wire B and C), you have to measure the voltage between Wire A and either one of them. If the voltage between A and B is less than between A and C(approximately 1V to 5V), wire B is the neutral wire and vice-versa.
