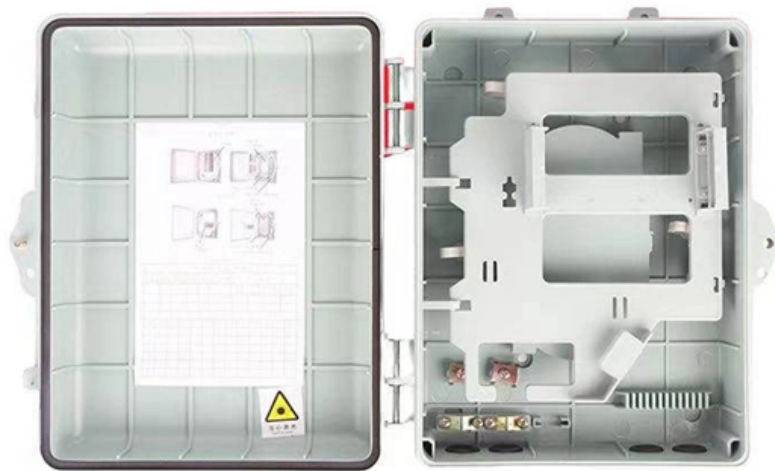

Some systems can also detect natural gas leaks or tampering with the system's equipment and send out a fire alarm.
