

What connector is used for PC pigtails





Overview

D38999 PCB connectors, or PC Tail connectors, are rugged circular connectors designed for direct soldering onto printed circuit boards (PCBs). They are built to MIL-DTL-38999 specifications, offering superior performance in harsh environments. Your PSU may have come with two separate PCIe 8-pin cables - one with a single 8-pin PCIe connector, and another with two 8-pin PCIe connectors, which we refer to as "pigtail". But is using the pigtail cable safe?

Or should you use two individual 8-pin cables?

Spoiler alert: Pigtail cables are safe. Each 8 pin connector is "rated" up to 150w, but the cable itself that goes to the PSU, is rated to supply up to 225w. Pigtail connectors are an essential component in a wide variety of technical applications — from audio systems and RF transmission to complex PC builds. In fiber optics, pigtails are fusion-spliced to field fiber inside splice trays — the most common termination method in telecom and data center networks. A short cable having a connection on one side and a segment of wires on the other is called a pigtail connector.
