Snedecor named the F-distribution after Sir Ronald Fisher in honor of his work on variance ratio. 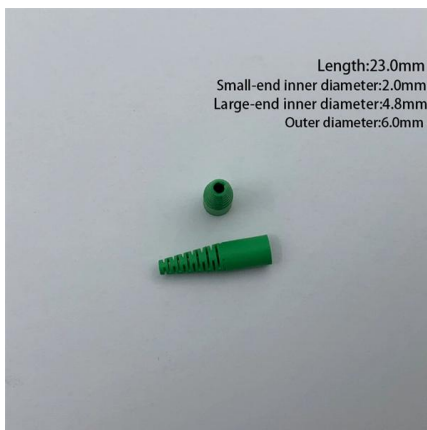

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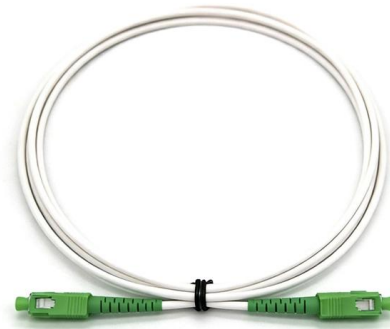

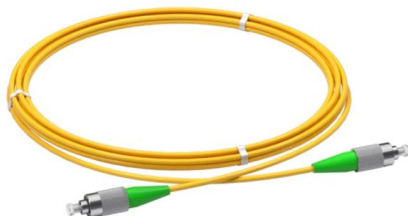
