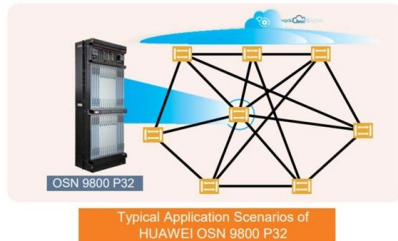

An electrical pigtail is a short piece of wire used to connect an electrical device, such as a switch or receptacle, to the main circuit conductors within a junction box. These small, often overlooked components ensure a strong, safe electrical connection. A jump wire (also known as jumper, jumper wire, DuPont wire) is an electrical wire, or group of them in a cable, with a connector or pin at each end (or sometimes without them – simply "tinned"), which is normally used to interconnect the components of a breadboard or other prototype or test.

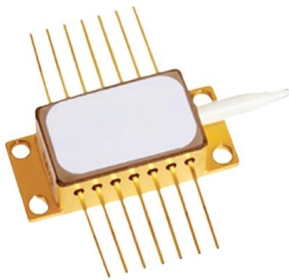
