Overview

The grounding conductor is commonly known as a "ground conductor" or "case ground. Grounding of the units: Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). Find the grounding bar or PE bar Open the distribution box and find the position marked with the grounding plate or PE letter. Your breaker box wiring includes three main wire types: black hot wires carry electricity to outlets, white neutral wires return unused power, and green ground wires prevent electrocution.

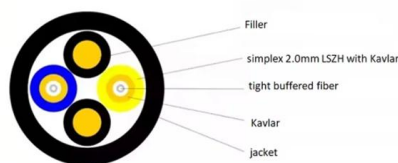

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

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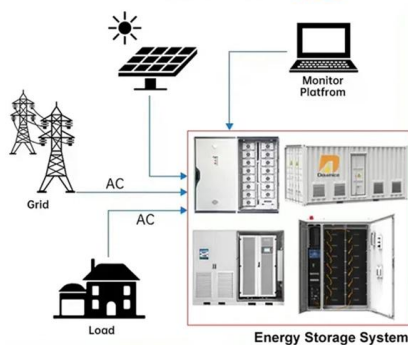
