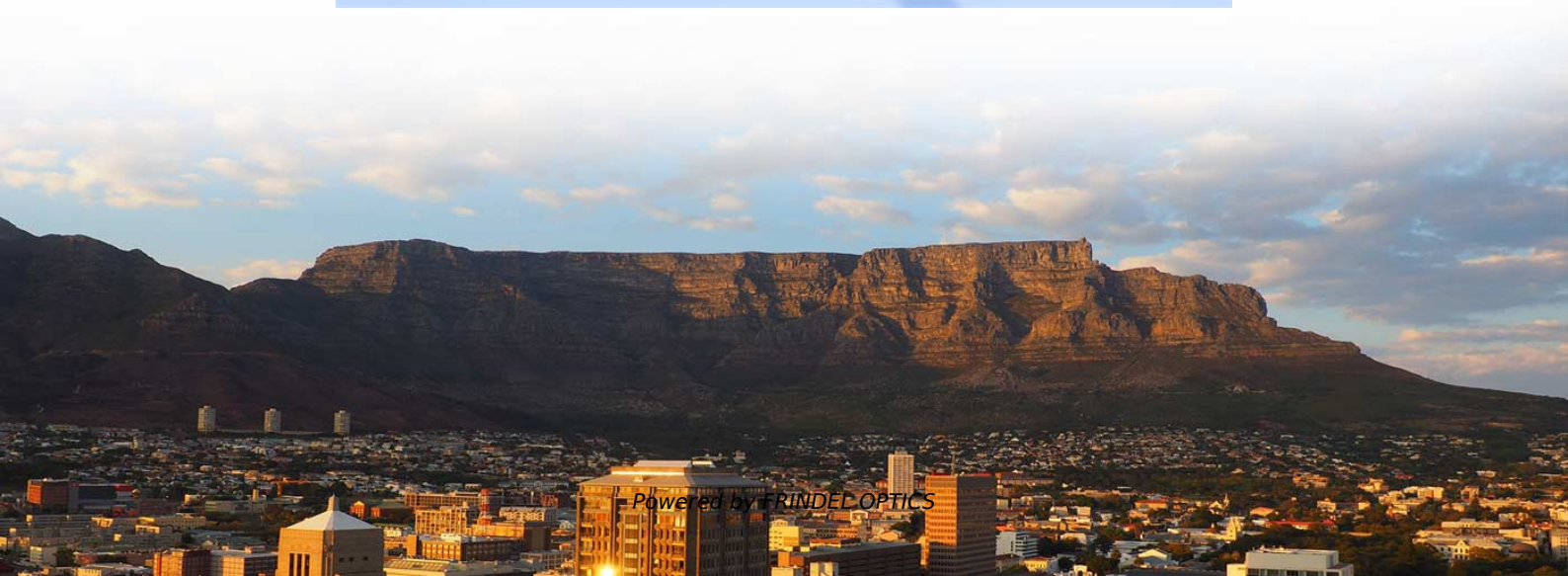

Silica is derived from naturally occurring quartz sand deposits found in regions such as the United States, Brazil, and Australia. Each strand is roughly the width of a human hair, yet a single fiber can carry hundreds of gigabits of data per second over distances that would cripple a. The innovation emerged as one of Corning's greatest success stories when scientists, in 1970, developed a way to transmit light through fiber without losing much of it along the way. 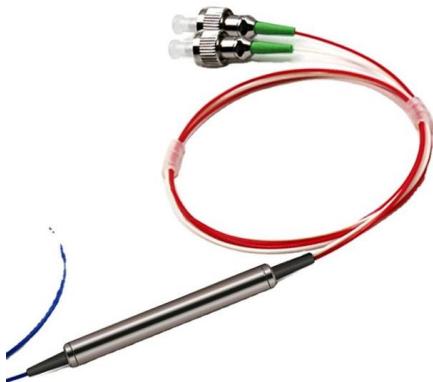

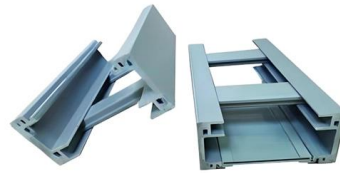

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How does light travel down a fibre optic cable?

At the core of the fibre optic cable is a strand of plastic or pure optical glass about 0.01mm in diameter. Surrounding it is a highly reflective cladding with a different refractive index to that of the core. The
