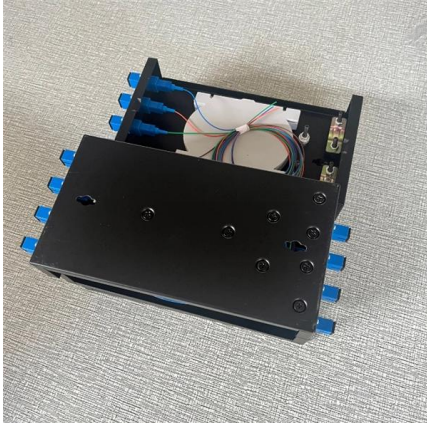

Static Power Converter: For devices such as rectifiers and inverters, the system grounding is determined by the grounding of the output stage of the converter. Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1.8m).
