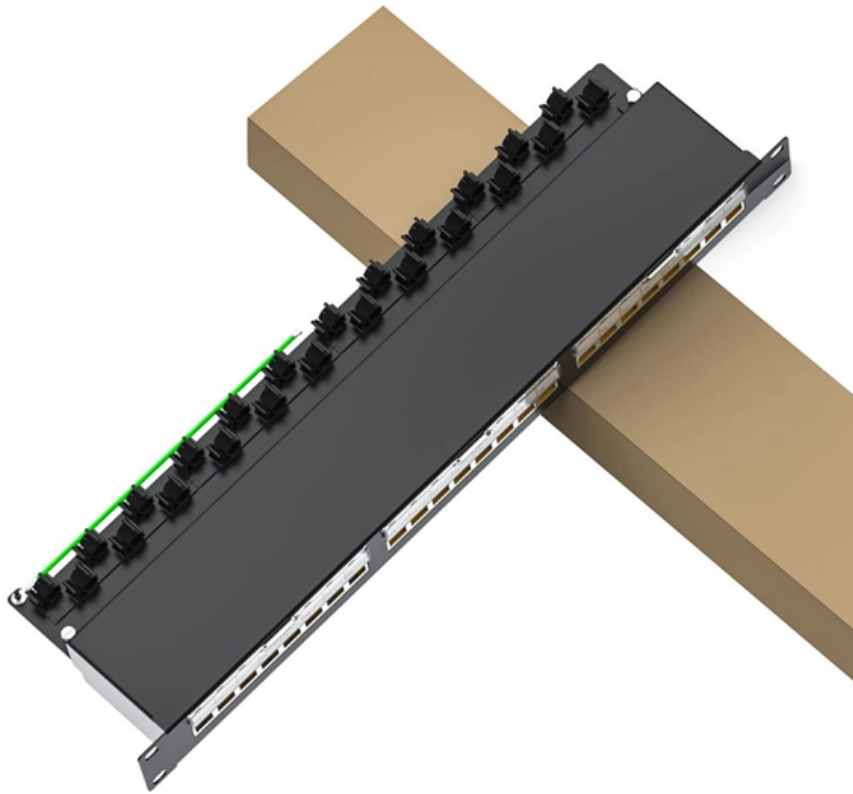


Will fiber optic cables be reformed



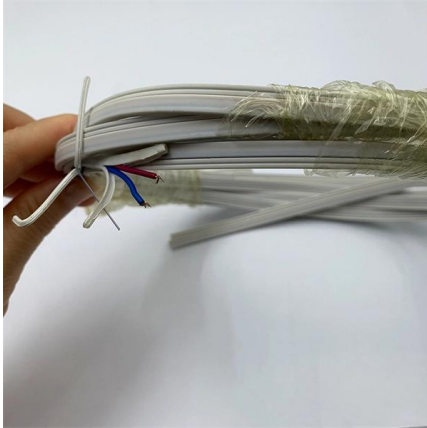


Overview
